This scholarship is in honor of valued and long time member of the Northern California Chapter of IFDA, Elaine McCune, FIFDA. An advocate and supporter of design students, education, and student programs for many years, she is a continuing presence behind and at these programs, in particular, the San Francisco Interior Design Student Career Forum.

**To qualify, you need to be a currently enrolled student in an interior design/interior architecture or home product design program at an accredited college, university, art or technical school in California.** You need to have successfully completed 12 semester units (or equivalent) of Interior Design course work and be currently carrying at least 6 semester units (or equivalent) when you apply. Please submit the following information with your application.

- Cover sheet with information indicated below.
- Your current resume
- A profile of your goals, work experience, and your area of concentration (maximum of one page)
- One letter of recommendation from an instructor
- Official, sealed transcripts verifying all college course work completed and in progress
- At least 4, but no more than 6 photographs of at least 3 different design projects demonstrating clearly evidence of your accomplishments, design skills, and effective presentation. They must be mounted (on sheets no larger than 8 ½" x 11") and include a short description of each illustration. The work may be represented by illustrations of spatial planning, lighting design, and/or may include examples of finish boards, elevations, or perspective drawings. For product design, photographs of original designs of furniture, lighting, textiles, and accessories should include dimensions, color renderings, and details of materials.

**Deadline:** Complete application materials must be submitted in an 8 ½" x 11" 3-ring binder (1/2" or 1" thick) and be postmarked by **June 30, 2010**. Submitted application materials become the property of IFDA, Northern California Chapter and will not be returned. Only complete applications postmarked by the deadline will be considered. The decision of the judges is final, including the decision to not make an award.
