## Plus Tour of Yosemite Valley

Join us for this special trip to enjoy two collections in the Sierras as well as a narrated tour of Yosemite Valley. Our day starts with a tour of the new exhibition space at the Wild Wonderful King Vintage Museum, including a special exhibition "Fashion Styles of the Decades 1900-1950". Many of the well documented items in the collection will be on display. We will then board a van for our visit to Yosemite National Park (and thus reducing the number of vehicles in this Park!). After having a no-host lunch at the Ahwahnee Hotel, we visit the Yosemite Museum. There will be time to walk through the Indian Village and Yosemite Visitor Center.
